Movie Matinee Trip

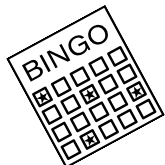

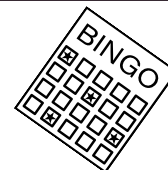
Senior Grocery Market
