

Crisis and Prevention Services Intern

Length of Internship: Minimum two semesters preferred; one semester required

Hours: Dependent on University's Requirements and agency needs

Function: Responsible for providing direct service and case management to clients in crisis who enter services from various referral sources, including family, school, Children's Advocacy Center, police departments, Juvenile Court Services, and self-referral methods. This intern ensures efficient and quality services are rendered to the community under the direct supervision of licensed mental health providers.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Provides individual and group counseling to Children's Advocacy Center clients on a scheduled basis
- Provides crisis counseling for walk-in and phone crises
- Conduct crisis for nonoffending parents and children through CAC
- Maintains up-to-date clinical documentation via the agency database
- Consults with professional staff and supervisors as needed
- Provides community education workshops and lectures to community partners
- Utilizes psychodiagnostic assessment procedures and psychometric methods to facilitate psychotherapy as needed
- Facilitate psychotherapy groups in a school-based or agency setting
- Other duties as appropriate

- Currently enrolled in a graduate-level program related to social services, counseling, family social services, or human services.

Requirements:

- Must be willing to undergo Background Checks.
- Must have Covid-19 vaccination
- Must be enrolled in a master's program.
- Must be able to comply with HIPAA regulations.
